Thank you again for choosing Joni's Child Care and Pre-School to care for your baby. This is going to be a fun and exciting time for you and your child. The days will be filled with new experiences, new faces and great new relationships. Sorting through all of the things your baby may need throughout the day can be quite a chore, so we have created the following list that may help you lighten your diaper bag (at least while at the center!)

1. Diapers – Many families choose to leave a package of diapers at the center. We will notify you on your child's daily sheet when your supply is getting low. Please label the package with your child's first name and last initial. We will label the individual diapers for you.
2. Wipes – The center provides wipes for all of the children. We use brands that are hypo-allergenic and fragrance-free. You will only have to provide wipes if your child is hyper-sensitive or requires a specific brand. Again, please label any container with your child's first name and last initial.
3. Diaper Rash Ointment – A supply may be left at the center with your child's name printed on it. Be sure to complete an authorization form for your child's file.
4. Small "Cubby" Box – A 1.5 gal. Size seems to work best for storing spare clothing while leaving room for blankets and other cubby extras that remain in the center day-to-day.
5. Extra clothing – Diapers do occasionally leak, so it is important to have at least 1 spare set of clothes, including socks and onesie.(2-3 sets may be best depending on your child's history.)

6. Formula or Breast milk – A separate, clean bottle is required for each feeding. A back-up supply is often helpful to be kept in your child's cubby of the freezer.
7. Food – As your child begins jarred foods and cereals, you may want to maintain a supply in the cubby. We will let you know when the supply needs replenished.
8. Printed Schedule – We will try to follow your child's usual routine as closely as possible.

You will not need to provide sheets, bibs, spoons, bowls or toys. The center provides these items and maintains and cleans them on a regular schedule.

You are encouraged to bring your child in for a "trial" day so that you may observe how the needs of different children are addressed and ask any questions that continue to pop-up as your start day continues. Again...
